


Calendar Survey Dissemination




• Option B: 54.06%

Calendar Survey Comments

- A lot do not like school starting so early in August and no option for a later start time on either option.
- Many like and/or want the long Winter Break.
- Many like school to end by Memorial Day while many do not care about school ending in June.
- Many appreciate the long Spring Break.
- Many like the term ending by Winter Break (Option A).
- Many want a shorter summer and more breaks during the year while other want a longer summer.
- Some want more frequent and shorter breaks while some want to consolidate days off.
- Some are appreciative that Fall Break is on the calendar and some want it to align to the state calendar (Option A).
- Some would like Fall Recess to be a full week while some say they don't need a Fall Recess.
- Some would like Thanksgiving to be a full week.
- Some would like November 1 to be a day off due to Halloween.
- A few want days off in May.
- A few would like a year-round option.
- A few would like Spring Break attached to Easter (April 17).
- A few do not want SEPs on Valentine's Day.
- A few say too many short weeks are hard on working parents.

Additional Comments

- Match the calendar to other districts, state universities, and even have a national calendar.
- Consider trimesters instead of quarters.
- Don't change the calendar once input is solicited.
- Make the calendar similar every year for easier planning in the future.
- Many are appreciative that they were able to give input and asked if we could publish the results as they wonder if anyone reads the comments.

Unrelated Comments

- Junior high and high school daily start times should be later.
- Early out Fridays for high schools would be easier that late start Mondays for babysitting reasons.
- Ninth grade should move to the high schools.
